CHAPTER TWO APPOINTMENTS

Section 201. Appointments of Delegates for Special Meetings

Appointments by the Chief of representatives and delegates to special meetings and conferences are hereby approved by the General Council, and require no further approval by the General Council or the Executive Committee.

Section 202. Appointment of Permanent Delegates.

Approval of appointments granted under Section 101 herein not apply to permanent representatives or delegates to councils, organizations or other bodies, which appointments shall require approval as provided by the Constitution and other ordinances.

Section 204. Approval of Contracts.

The Principal Chief is authorized by the Seminole Nation General Council pursuant to the Seminole Constitution, Article V, Section f, to execute contracts that do not exceed the Simplified Acquisition Threshold on behalf of the Nation. The amounts of the Simplified Acquisition Threshold is defined in the Federal Acquisition Regulations at 48 C.F.R. § 2.101.
