

Public Notice

Pursuant to Title 10, Section 410, *Run-Off Elections*, the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma will conduct a Run-Off Election for the office of Assistant Chief. The Run-Off Election will be held on August 10, 2013.

Pursuant to Title 10, Section 405(a), *Voting Precinct*, precinct locations are:

Precinct 1: Sasakwa Community Building (Sasakwa, OK)

Precinct 2: North Community Building (Mekusukey Mission)

Precinct 3: Strother Community Building (Strother Community)

Precinct 4: Glorietta Baptist Church (7308 S. Western Avenue, Oklahoma City, OK)

Precinct 5: Haikey Chapel (8815 E. 101st, Tulsa, OK)

In accordance with Title 10, Section 405(b), polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. and, **in accordance with Title 10, Section 405(c), a voter must vote at his or her assigned voting precinct.**

A Tribal enrollment card or a proper form of photo identification must be presented at time of voting.

An absentee ballot request for the run-off election will automatically be mailed to voters that received an absentee ballot in the primary election. Voters that did not request an absentee ballot, or submitted their request after the deadline, will have to submit a new request.

Absentee ballot request forms are available in the Election Board Office and on the Seminole Nation of Oklahoma website at sno-nsn.gov. The request form must be received in the Election Board Office by close of business at 5:00 p.m. on July 22, 2013. Absentee ballots must be received by the Election Board no later than the last mail run on August 10, 2013.

The Election Board Office is located on the north side of the North Community Building, Mekusukey Mission. Office hours are 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The office telephone number is 405-303-2000.
